If you own your home, live in the Spring Hill School District, and meet the following criteria please complete this application.

1. You must be low-income and a homeowner
2. You must be a senior citizen, person with a disability, &/or a spouse on military deployment
3. You must be unable to complete the work on your own
4. You must plan to remain in your home for the next 2 to 5 years
5. Your Property taxes must be paid

*If your house is selected for rehabilitation, financial information will be required.
