The City of Spring Hill wants everyone to enjoy the 4th of July in a safe and responsible manner. Please respect your neighborhood and clean up after your celebration event. Remember there are those in the community that may not choose to celebrate with fireworks and respect for these individuals is requested as well as considerations for pets in the neighborhood.

Fireworks can be sold on June 27th through July 5th between 8am - 10pm.

Fireworks can be used or discharged July 1st through July 5th from 8am - 11pm and again on December 31st - January 1st from 11pm - 12:30am.

If a fire ban is issued or declaration of an emergency, the use of fireworks shall be prohibited. The sale of fireworks will be permitted.

At least one approved fire extinguisher is required at the exhibition site.

## PROJECT 17...WHAT IS IT?

The Kansas Leadership Center is working in partnership with the people in 17 Kansas counties to make the area a better place to live and work.

Project 17 is a wide-ranging effort that aims to use regional cooperation to improve the economy and quality of life in an area bordered by Miami and Franklin counties on the north, Greenwood and Chautauqua counties on the west and Cherokee County in the southeast.



The effort derives from input from citizen interviews, surveys and direct participation in an economic improvement summit. Project 17 was chosen from 21 statewide applicants for the Kansas Leadership Center's unique training on civic engagement. KLC's Project 17 Leadership Initiative will provide leadership training valued at up to \$1 million. KLC has agreed to help regional participants turn the tide on these tough public issues.

The tough public issue Spring Hill is gathering ideas, hearing your experiences, and taking action on is the concern of Childhood Poverty. With over 1,046 kids in Miami County living in poverty, we are touched by this swelling concern and are asking the question... How can we make a difference for families in our Spring Hill Community?


Participant Discussion based on 3 questions:
