Members requested more information on the revenue tax that was established for Spring Hill Aquatic Center and Veteran's Park (formerly West Lake Park). They would also like to view the updated plan for Veteran's Park.
- Parks Master Plan update was provided by Larry Reynolds, representative from Vireo. Mr. Reynolds presented various questions and formats for disseminating requests for feedback from the community. Board members were asked to participate by completing an online survey.
