

Spring Hill Cemetery Board Meeting
Tuesday, May 5, 2020 7:00 p.m. Telephone Conference

Members present: Larry Sumner, Joy Rose, Bill Peterman, Susan Crawford, Christine Hecke

Christine Hecke called the meeting to order. Susan Crawford made a motion to accept the April minutes and Joy Rose seconded the motion. Motion passed. The treasurer's report was given with the following: checking account \$5,794.59, saving account \$34,269.28 and CD's \$14,476.27 and \$60,034.08. Larry Sumner made a motion to pay Downey Lawn Care \$900 for mowing and Lonnie Van Arsdale \$1035 for leveling graves, seeding and dirt work. Bill Peterman seconded the motion. Bill Peterman presented information he gathered from visiting other cemeteries about road widths and location advantages of ground level stones and upright stones. Bill Peterman made a motion to make the spaces in the new cemetery addition to measure 46 inches wide by 9 feet long. Larry Sumner seconded the motion. Motion passed. The Avenue of Flags will be displayed for Memorial Day on Saturday, May 23 to Monday, May 25. Larry Sumner gave the proposed budget for the next two years to the city. Larry Sumner and his son-in-law worked to get the trees removed from the west fence line on the Sowers property. They provided this work at no charge. We will be working with the American Legion and Ruritans to place the Branches of Service flags along this area. Christine Hecke will talk to the city about the getting the gates of the cemetery open each day. Bill Peterman made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second from Larry Sumner. Meeting adjourned.
