

CITY SERVICES

WHAT WE DO

We provide efficient wastewater service for all Spring Hill residents and contract with Waste Management for garbage and recycling collection. Weekly trash and recycling pickup is as follows: residents north of 207th St. are serviced on Thursdays and south of 207th St. are serviced on Fridays.

Utility statements for sewer and trash are mailed on the first working day of the month. Payments not received by the due day each month will incur a 10% penalty fee. This penalty is added to the account balance, and a delinquent notice is mailed if the account is 60 days past due.

Contact us to round up your bill to support the Johnson County Multi-Service Center Utility Assistance program, which directly benefits Spring Hill residents.

HOW TO PAY

- Online at springhillks.gov
- At City Hall by credit card, cash, check, or money order. A drop box is available outside City Hall for after-hours payments. Don't leave cash in the drop box.
- By mail to P.O. Box 424, Spring Hill, KS 66083.
- By phone at 1-833-431-1750. You will need your account number and house number.

PET REQUIREMENTS

Spring Hill regulations DON'T require residents to register their dogs and cats with the City. However, pets are required to be current on rabies vaccinations. Regulations also state that residents are limited to two dogs. You can get a third dog permit at City Hall. Spring Hill welcomes all breeds of dogs within city limits.

BUILDING PERMITS

A basic building permit is required for projects, including remodeling, finishing a basement, building a deck, or building an accessory or agricultural building. Contact Community Development at 913-592-3657 for more information.

Near the intersection of 223rd and Harrison streets

Celia Dayton Park

Southeast corner of Franklin and Allen streets

City Park

Northwest corner of Hale and Washington streets

Friendship Park

401 N. Madison St., just north of City Hall

Legacy Park

Access is on a path within the Woodland Ridge subdivision at the intersection of 208th St. and Skyview Lane.

Veterans Park

Intersection of 199th Street and Veterans Lane, just west of U.S. 169. Also includes Melvin Murry Dog Park.

City Lake

Near U.S. 169 and Lone Elm Road. Access to the lake is at the Sycamore Ridge Golf Course entrance.
