# CITY SERVICES

## WHAT WE DO

We provide efficient wastewater service for all residents and quality water service for many of our residents. We contract with Waste Management for garbage and recycling collection. All Spring Hill residents have their weekly trash and recycling pickup on Friday.

Utility statements are mailed the first working day of the month and are due upon receipt. Payments not received by the 15th of the month incur a 5 percent penalty fee on water and sewer. This penalty is added to the account balance and a delinquent notice is mailed if the account is 60 days past due.

- At City Hall by credit card, cash, check or money order. A dropbox is available outside of City Hall for after-hours payments but we ask that you do not leave cash in the drop box.
- By mail to P.O. Box 424, Spring Hill, KS 66083.
- By phone at 1 (833) 431-1750. You will need your account number and house number.

## PET LICENSES

Spring Hill regulations require that all dogs (two dog limit) and cats must be licensed. Licenses are due on or before March 1. If you recently moved to town, please register your pet(s) within 30 days. A third dog permit can be obtained at City Hall.

Application for animal licensing must be submitted to City Hall. You must provide documentation showing your pet's current rabies vaccination with the application.

## BUILDING PERMITS

A basic building permit is required for projects including remodeling, finishing a basement, building a deck or building an accessory or agricultural building. Contact Community Development at (913) 592-3657 for more information.

### Veterans Park (coming June 2020!)

*Intersection of 199th Street and Veterans Lane, just west of U.S. 169. Also includes Melvin Murry Dog Park.*

### City Lake

*Near U.S. 169 and Lone Elm Road, access to the lake is by way of the Sycamore Ridge Golf Course entrance.*
