CITY SERVICES

WHAT WE DO

We provide efficient wastewater service for all residents and quality water service for many of our residents. We contract with Waste Management for garbage and recycling collection. Weekly trash and recycling pickup for all Spring Hill residents is on Friday.

Utility statements are mailed the first working day of the month and are due upon receipt. Payments not received by the 15th of the month incur a 5 percent penalty fee on water and sewer. This penalty is added to the account balance and a delinquent notice is mailed if the account is 60 days past due.

Contact us to round up your bill to support the Johnson County Multi-Service Center utility assistance program, which directly benefits Spring Hill residents.

HOW TO PAY

- Online at www.springhillks.gov
- At City Hall by credit card, cash, check or money order. A dropbox is available outside of City Hall for after-hours payments but we ask that you do not leave cash in the drop box.
- By mail to P.O. Box 424, Spring Hill, KS 66083.
- By phone at 1 (833) 431-1750. You will need your account number and house number.

PET REQUIREMENTS

Spring Hill regulations DO NOT require residents to register their dogs and cats with the City. However, pets are required to be current on rabies vaccinations. Regulations also state residents are limited to two dogs. A third dog permit can be obtained at City Hall. Spring Hill welcomes all breeds of dogs in the city limits.

BUILDING PERMITS

A basic building permit is required for projects including remodeling, finishing a basement, building a deck or building an accessory or agricultural building. **Coming soon: The ability to apply and pay for most permits online!** Contact Community Development at (913) 592-3657 for more information.

Legacy Park

Access is on a path within the Woodland Ridge subdivision at the intersection of 208th St. and Skyview Lane.

Veterans Park

Intersection of 199th Street and Veterans Lane, just west of U.S. 169. Also includes Melvin Murry Dog Park.

City Lake

Near U.S. 169 and Lone Elm Road, access to the lake is by way of the Sycamore Ridge Golf Course entrance.
