Daily admission: \$5
Twilight admission (after 6 p.m.): \$3.50
Senior admission (62 and older): Free
Toddler admission (2 and under): Free
Punch pass (10 visits): \$40
Preregistered group (12+ members): \$3.50 per person

ABOUT OUR SEASON PASSES

Season passes are a card-style pass with a photo ID. Family passes are available for up to six family members. The passholders must include at least one but no more than two parent(s) or guardian(s) and their dependents under age 23.

Passes are 10 percent off through April 30.

RENTALS

You can host up to 300 guests for a birthday party, family reunion or corporate event by renting all or part of the Aquatic Center after-hours. Rental times are available Friday and Saturday from 8:15 p.m. to 10:15 p.m. and Sunday from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. or 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. Hosts may bring their own food and beverages.

OPTION 1: Zero-depth/kiddie pool with rain drop, bucket feature, frog slide and family slide. *50 guests*

Two hours Friday, Saturday or Sunday: \$155

Three hours Sunday: \$230

OPTION 2: Main pool, diving boards, climbing wall and drop slide *100 guests*

Two hours Friday, Saturday or Sunday: \$200

Three hours Sunday: \$300

OPTION 3: Options 1 and 2 bundled. *150 guests*

Two hours Friday, Saturday or Sunday: \$275

Three hours Sunday: \$400

OPTION 4: Entire facility, including lazy river and north River Tube slide *300 guests*

Two hours Friday, Saturday or Sunday: \$400

Three hours Sunday: \$600

RESERVE WITH US TODAY

To reserve the Spring Hill Aquatic Center or a cabana, visit us at City Hall, 401 N. Madison St. Full payment is due at the time of reservation. If the pool is closed due to weather conditions (as determined by Aquatic Center management), every attempt will be made to reschedule. If the party cannot be rescheduled, a refund will be considered.

After-hours reservations or upgrades to another package must be made at least 10 days in advance.

Glass containers, smoking, pets and alcohol are prohibited at the Spring Hill Aquatic Center at all times.

The north half of the River Tube Slide — located on the east side of the Aquatic Center — will be open to patrons this year. If the north half experiences the same liner failure as the south half, it will be evaluated for closure.



DAY IN THE SHADE: POOLSIDE CABANA RENTALS

Our spacious cabanas are a great place to enjoy a lazy day in the shade. Rental times are available as follows:

- 12:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.
- 2:45 p.m. to 4:45 p.m.
- 5 p.m. to 7 p.m.

A \$30 fee is charged per two-hour increment. Reservations may be made on site or in advance at City Hall.

PRIVATE + GROUP SWIM LESSONS

Private swim lessons are a great way for your child to receive personalized, one-on-one instruction. Each lesson is structured to address the student's abilities.

Rates: Three 45-minute lessons for \$60 or six lessons for \$100

High-quality group swim lessons that accommodate a range of skill levels and ages are offered at the Aquatic Center. We offer three levels of swim lessons for children six months to 12 years. Prices for group swim lessons are still being established for the 2020 season. We will provide prices when available on our social media, website and future newsletter.

WATER FITNESS

River walking is an excellent exercise — this low-impact workout is great for joints, muscles, and bones. The water's resistance helps you to build strength while you stay cool. The lazy river at the Spring Hill Aquatic Center will be open to walkers Monday through Friday mornings. Walkers must be 16 and older to participate in this activity.

River walking punch passes can be purchased at City Hall (starting March 1) or at the Aquatic Center (starting May 24). A \$15 punch pass covers five visits.

HOW TO RESERVE

Birthday party packages must be made at least 10 days in advance. Upgrades to another package may be made up to four days prior to the party. Two party packages may be booked for larger groups or multiple birthday children.

Our facility will be open when the temperature is above 72 degrees and weather permits. We are closed when severe weather or lightning is present, low air temperatures or low attendance. No refunds are given for weather-related closings. For evening events, the pool will close one hour prior to the start of the event. Weather or event closings will be noted on the voicemail at the Aquatic Center and on our Facebook page.

We said goodbye last month to one of our longtime staff members.

Toni Woods, Utility Billing Accounting Clerk, retired Feb. 28 from the City of Spring Hill. Toni worked for the City for 17 years.

Beginning her career in November 2002, Toni started in utility billing and then transferred to Public Works to be an administrative assistant. For 10 years, she worked with staff, contractors, residents and others to improve our city. In 2014, she transferred back to Utility Billing and overhauled the position.
