


Season passes are a card-style pass with a photo ID. Family passes are available for up to six family members. The passholders must include at least one but no more than two parent(s) or guardian(s) and their dependents under age 23. More than six family members can be on the pass for an additional \$15 charge each.

Visit us in person to purchase a 2024 season pass. Passes are available for purchase at the Civic Center beginning April 1 through May 24 during business hours. Beginning May 26, visit the Aquatic Center to purchase a pass.

Facility rentals

The entire Aquatic Center or part of the facility can be rented for private events. Rentals are scheduled after regular business hours on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays from June 7 through August 3.

cabana rentals


Our spacious cabanas accommodate up to 16 guests and are a great place to enjoy a lazy day in the shade. Rentals are \$30 per two-hour increment. When booking a cabana, you may also purchase admission in advance for the preregistered group discount. Cabanas may be rented for birthday parties.

Outside food and drinks are permitted with a cabana rental.

how to reserve

To reserve a cabana or rent the Spring Hill Aquatic Center, visit the Aquatic Center during normal business hours or email poolmanager@springhillks.gov. Full payment is due at the time of reservation. After-hours reservations must be made at least 14 days in advance.

Glass containers, smoking, pets and alcohol are prohibited at the Spring Hill Aquatic Center at all times.


But wait — there's more! We will be adding additional events throughout the summer. Events will be added to the calendar at springhillks.gov and on the Aquatic Center's Facebook page.

Our facility will be open when the temperature is above 72 degrees and weather permits. We are closed when severe weather or lightning is present, low air temperature or low attendance. No refunds are given for weather-related closings. For evening events, the pool will close 30 minutes prior to the start of the event. Weather or event closings will be noted on the voicemail at the Aquatic Center and on our Facebook page.

Swim Lessons for the kids

The City of Spring Hill has contracted with the YMCA of Greater Kansas City to provide high-quality swim lessons that accommodate a range of skill levels and ages, from infants to 12 years old. Each lesson is structured to use the students' current abilities and move them forward. Sessions include eight 45-minute lessons. Water Fitness for the kids at heart

River walking is an excellent exercise — this low-impact workout is great for joints, muscles, and bones. The water's resistance helps you to build strength while you stay cool. Walkers must be 16 and older to participate in this activity. Morning sessions occur during swim lessons. Admission is \$3 per session or free with river walking season pass. The evening river walking session takes place during pool hours. Walkers may use a river walking season pass or pay the daily admission (65+ get in free).

Drug Take Back Day

Cleaning out your medicine cabinet could help prevent theft, drug abuse, and potentially save a life.

The Spring Hill Police Department is partnering with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and law enforcement agencies from across the country to host a National Prescription Take Back Day event on April 27, 2024, from 10 a.m. - 2 p.m. at the police station at 418 E Nichols St.

Members of the public can dispose of unwanted or expired medication for free at the no-questions-asked disposal event.

Items accepted at Take Back Day:

- Prescription and over-the-counter pills
- Vitamins
- Medicated ointments and lotions
- Pet medication

Liquids, aerosol cans and needles are not accepted at Take Back Day.

New Open Gym hours

Starting April 1st, there will be changes to the open gym hours at the Civic Center. Open gym will now be available every Thursday from 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m., a change from the previous timing which extended until 7:30 p.m. Due to low attendance, open gym will no longer be offered on Saturdays. Please note that the calendar on the City's website will be updated to reflect any changes due to holidays or previously scheduled events.

Open gym is open to all ages. Participants are required to sign a waiver, and those under 18 must have a guardian's signature on the waiver. Children aged 12 and younger must be accompanied by an adult aged 18 or older.

Additionally, the gym is available to rent for a fee.

Weekly yard waste collection guidelines

Waste Management collects up to eight bags or bundles of yard waste from each household every week. Be sure to follow these guidelines:

- Bags must be compostable and may not

be stapled or taped

- Brush must be tied into bundles no longer than 48" with string or twine.
- Plastic bags of any kind will not be accepted.
